STV Application Order - May 16, 2022

In my Order on Applications for Standing and Funding dated March 3, 2022, I determined that STV Incorporated ("STV"), which was part of the Capital Transit Partners Joint Ventures, met the criteria for standing set out under the *Public Inquiries Act*, S.O. 2009, c. 33, Schedule 6. (the "Act") and the Commission's Rules. However, in its application, STV requested to limit its participation only to having access to the Commission's database of documents and the right to comment on background materials or written evidence prepared by Commission Counsel. Accordingly, I granted STV that limited right of participation.

STV now brings an application for full standing relating to (1) the procurement, design and building of the LRT and (2) the delivery, operation, maintenance, repair, and rehabilitation of the LRT. It states that since initially seeking a limited right of participation in the Inquiry, it has determined that its role in the Inquiry will likely be more significant than it originally anticipated.

The application for full standing is granted. I remain of the view that STV meets the criteria for standing set out under the Act and the Commission's Rules. Accordingly, I order that STV shall have the full rights of participation as listed in paragraph 16 of the Rules of Standing and Funding.
