This completes the list of items to be provided with SONOs as part of the Safety Audit in support of Revenue Service Availability (RSA).

The SONO items form the basis of the overall Safety Audit Report, however, there are a number of remaining items that prevent a positive statement regarding use of the System for Passenger-Carrying Operations. The notable remaining items that are to be reviewed and closed-out prior to the issuing of the Safety Audit Report for Passenger-Carrying Operations are as follows:

- A final review of the ORD against the Pre-Revenue Service Deficiency and Deferred
 Works in order to ensure that any of the items identified that have the potential to impact
 safety have an associated ORD item. This will be a dynamic activity that will potentially
 evolve as any new items are identified and existing items closed.
- Finalization of the Conditions, Limitations and Requirements identified in the Alstom
 Preliminary Fleet Safety Certificate (Rev 8) including resolution the Mission Plan B for
 Spotters on the platform to mitigate against the issues with the onboard display of
 platform cameras.
- · Review of the Test Certificate Letter
- Completion of the review of Configuration Item Lists for Thales and Alstom Primary Systems

Note that the items identified above do not impact the RSA and are typical activities associated with the final version of the Safety Audit Report in support of Passenger-Carrying Operations.
