In my opinion, RTG is totally consumed with achieving Substantial Completion (SC) and then RSA. And I am willing to bet that a significant part of their SC efforts are aimed at establishing blame on Alstom for RTG not achieving RSA on time. Those very different and likely divergent priorities get in the way of RTG/RTM establishing, nurturing and solidifying their relationship with OC Transpo. It is possible (very likely?) that you I won't be able to get to the point where the relationship becomes positive and grows until after you get past SC and RSA. And until you reach "critical mass" on the SC/RSA issue efforts to address will be met with some level of opposition and lack of commitment.

Apologies. See attached. Occurred around 7:00 PM last night. In brief, an attempt was made to couple two LRVs without the coupler being extended on one of them. The ensuing connection caused damage to both LRVs. We are waiting on Alstom for a repair timeline but in the meantime here is the preliminary report they issued to RTM this afternoon and the OLRTC Report.

This fell between the RTG team members – I assumed we had advised OCT - it is a property damage only, no one was injured so it didn't escalate through that route obviously.

Clearly a failure on our part to immediately advise the client, so we will revisit our notification strategy as part of the investigation and provide you with a full report including the measures in place to ensure it does not happen again. In the meantime we've also asked Alstom to improve their process (use of walk around checklist prior to commencing coupling).

As soon as we have any update from Alstom regarding schedule we will communicate with you and your team.
