Her email dated May 3, 2022 is clear to me that Mr Wardle was not acting as my Counsel, rather, he has been hired by the City of Ottawa for the City of Ottawa.</p> <p>“The City’s external lawyers will be present during your interview. For the first half of 2020, the schedule of <u>regular</u> Transit Commission meetings was as follows:</p> <p>January: No Meeting  February: Took place on the 19<sup>th</sup>  March: No Meeting  April: No Meeting  May: No Meeting  June: Took place on the 17<sup>th</sup></p> <p>As I stated, the Commission went four months without a regular Transit Commission meeting.</p> <p>Counsel for the City of Ottawa then challenged my statements for calls for a meeting, given the various issues that we have been faced this term of office.</p> <p>Multiple requests, both formal and informal this term have been made to the Chair and/or City Clerk’s office.</p>
