Pathfinder to Marriage Registrations

This Pathfinder will guide you through the **Indexes** to the **Registration Number** and then to the **Registration**. To find the matching microfilm reel numbers for the Indexes and the Registrations, consult the appendix listings in the *Marriages Binder* for *Inventory 80 (Records of the Office of the Registrar General)* or follow the links below. The microfilm is available in the Archives Reading Room and through interlibrary loan.

<u>Please note</u>: Marriages are no longer microfilmed as of 1932 and can only be accessed through ancestry.ca, which holds digital birth records from 1872-1940; <u>click here to access the ancestry.ca</u> <u>website</u>. Ancestry can be accessed without a membership at the Archives of Ontario and many public libraries at <u>ancestryinstitution.ca</u>. The registrations for 1869-1927 are also available for free (with registration) on the Family Search website; <u>click here to access the Family Search website</u>.
